18-Wk Red Team Leaders Course (RTLCL)

Description: 18-wk RTLCL is primary RT Leaders Course. Students are exposed to, study and research: Red Team TTP; application of diverse theories; doctrine related to war gaming, coalition, and adversaries; regional military and civil cultural anthropology; and, application of these to various contemporary operational environments. Students use case studies and actual operations planning and have an opportunity to provide feedback to deployed commands. 18-week RTLCL is taught at Master's Degree level. Prior to nominating students, commanders must know: RTLCL is conducted in Seminar fashion; majority of students will be in ranks O4-O6; most students have attained senior military and civilian educational levels. Students must contribute in Seminar which meets 4 hrs/day using remaining day for next day's readings/assignments. Readings avg. 200 pages/night often accompanied by additional research/writing assignments.

Training Audience: 18-wk RTLCL is intended for Army officers in grades O4-O6 who are command designated unit RT Leaders serving in ASCC, Corps, Division and BCTs (O4-O5 for BCT/DIV HQS and O4-O6 for CORPS/ASCC HQS). By exception, 18-wk RTLCL may be open to commander selected: senior Captains (O3), Warrant Officers (CW3 and above), senior Enlisted (E8 and above), and DoD civilians (GS12 and above). SI/ASI 7G is awarded on completion of RTLCL. 2-year Active Duty Service Obligation (ADSO) is applied by HRC; graduates expected to serve one year utilization tour in RTL position to meet unit MTOE staffing requirements.

9-Wk Stop-Gap Red Team Leaders Course (SG RTLCL)

Description: 9-wk SG RTLCL exposes students to similar study and research subjects as primary RTLCL. SG RTLCL is HQDA G2/G3 directed course while Army is in OIF/OEF. SG RTLCL is designed to increase flow of trained RT Leaders in ARFORGEN rotation schedule units. Priority is to deploying Army officers in ranks O4-O6. Commanders are encouraged to send RT Leader designees to SG RTLCL well prior to rotation. 9SG RTLCL is taught at Master's Degree level. Prior to nominating officers, commanders must know: SG RTLCL is conducted in Seminar fashion; majority of students will be in ranks O4 to O6; and, most students have attained senior military and civil educational levels. Students must contribute in Seminar which meets 4 hrs/day using remaining day for next day's readings/assignments. Readings avg. 200 pages/night often accompanied by additional research/writing assignments.

Training Audience: 9-wk SG RTLCL is intended for Army officers in grades O4-O6 who are command designated unit RT Leaders serving in ASCC, Corps, Division and BCTs (O4-O5 for BCT/DIV HQS and O4-O6 for CORPS/ASCC HQS). Officers must have completed CGSC/ILE (MEL IV). SG RTLCL is not normally open to other personnel without HQDA G-3 and Director UFMCS approved waivers. By exception, SG RTLCL may be open to commander selected: senior Captains (O3), Warrant Officers (CW3 and above), senior Enlisted (E8 and above), and DoD Civilians (GS12 and above). SI/ASI 7G is awarded on completion of course. NO ADSO; graduates expected to serve one year utilization tour in RTL position in OIF/OEF to meet unit MTOE staffing requirements.

6-Week Red Team Members Course (RTMC)

Description: 6-wk RTMC is primary Red Team Members Course, NOT intended for designated unit RTLs. RTMC is less focused on RT Leader education on theories, cultural anthropology and operational environments, more focused on practical RT TTP training to prepare individuals for duty on a Red Team concentrating more on management of RT functions, tasks and TTP operating in ASCC, Corps, Division or BCT HQS. Prior to nominating students, commanders must know: RTMC is conducted in Seminar fashion; majority of students in class will be in grades senior Enlisted (E-7 and above with ANCOG) through O5 (ILE is not required); most have attained senior military and civil education levels. Students must contribute in Seminar which meets 4 hrs/day using remaining day for next day's readings/assignments. Readings avg. 150 pages/night often accompanied by additional research/writing assignments.

Training Audience: 6-wk RTMC is open to command designated Red Team Members who are to serve on the unit's Red Team, but not in the RT Leaders position. The RTMC is open to Officers (O3 and above), Warrant Officers (W/O3 and above), senior Enlisted (E7 and above having completed ANCOG), and DoD Civilians (GS12 and above) command designated to attend. SI/ASI 7J is awarded on completion of the course to meet unit MTOE staffing requirements. There is NO ADSO; graduates expected to serve utilization tour in RTM position to meet unit MTOE staffing requirements.

2-Week Critical Thinking Red Team Practitioners Course (CT RTPC)

Description: 2-wk CT RTPC introduces Army soldiers to specific RT skills: critical thinking, theory, culture, and communications. It is designed to familiarize students with concepts for considering alternate perspectives and challenging assumptions; enhances expertise beyond organic capability; CT RTPC enhances soldier's ability to critically review operational environment. Upon request, UFMCS conducts CT RTPC primarily as mobile training team (MTT) for Army and Joint units; alternatively, as resident course. In case of MTT, requesting unit must identify training requirement through SMDR process if known far enough in advance or TRAP process for execution year.

Training Audience: 2-wk CT RTPC is open to command designated Army Soldiers at unit level (officer, WO, NCO). CT RTPC is taught primarily as MTT based on unit requests submitted through ACOM; also taught in-residence at UFMCS, Ft Leavenworth. CT RTPC does not award SI/ASI. Registration through ATRRS. No security clearance required for MTT; unit provides unclassified classroom. SECRET or higher clearance required for resident. CT RTPC is graduate-level seminar style instruction: 4 hours in class / day (20 ICH per week); 4 hours individual research / day (20 hours / week) Whether MTT or resident course, each 8-hour class day must be students' sole duty during course. Non-contact hours must not be used for routine unit activities. Lessons are extensive, in-depth, built upon preparation prior to class; students must complete preparations.
